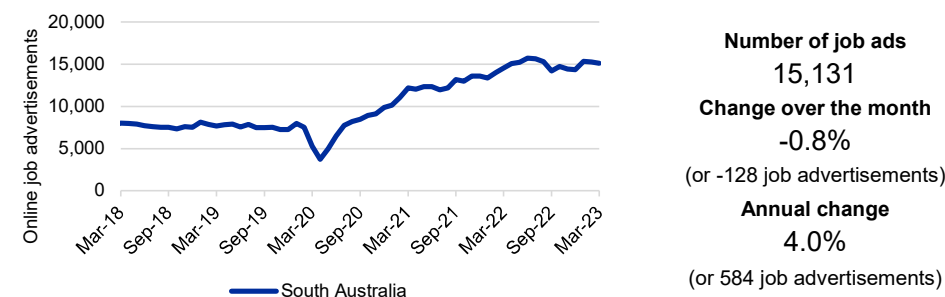

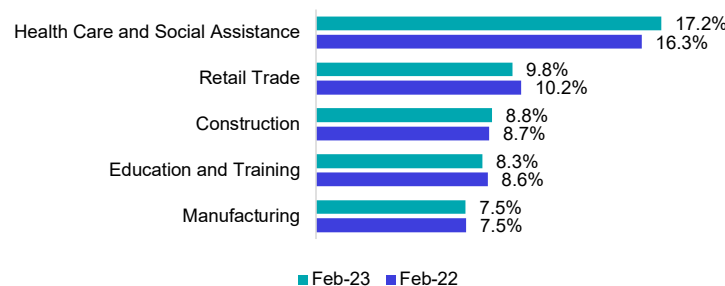

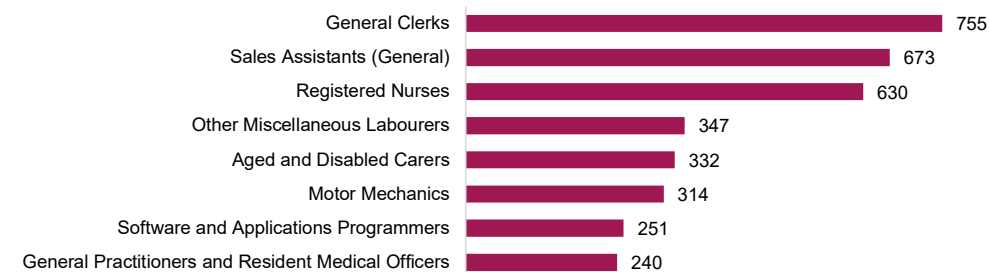

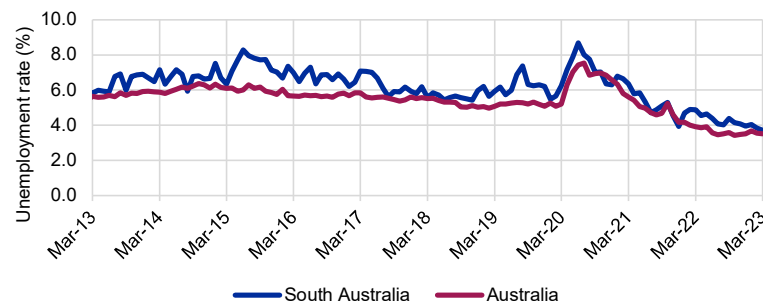

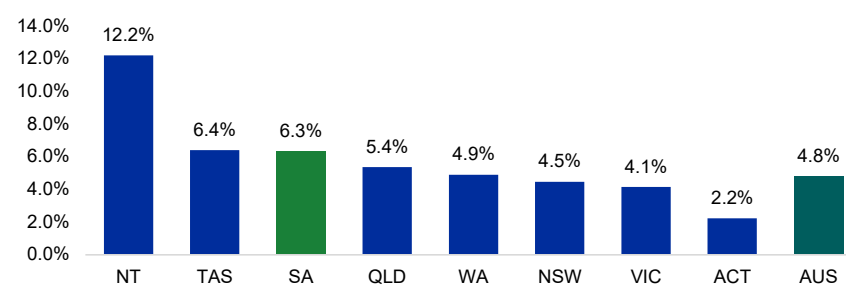

Unemployment rate



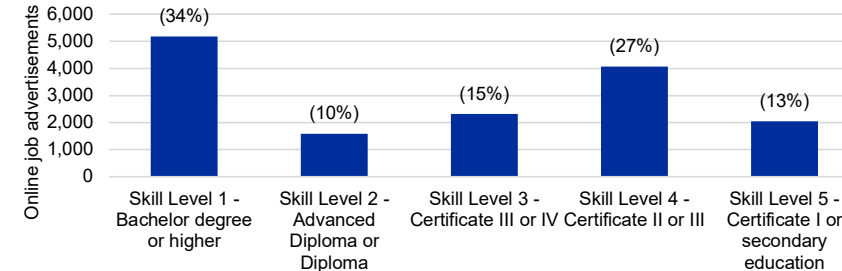

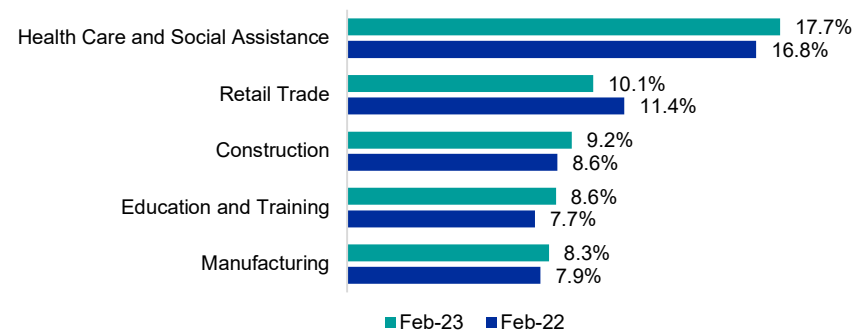

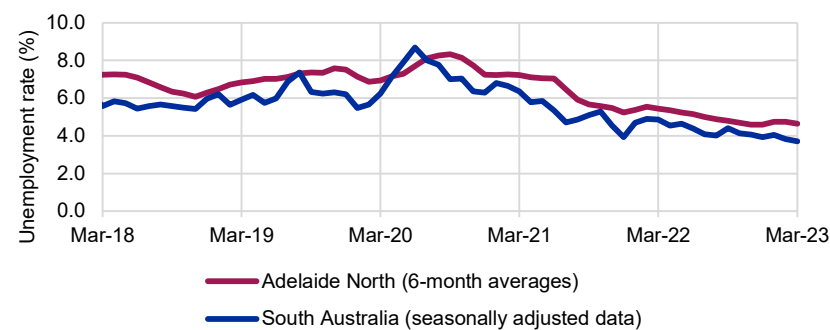

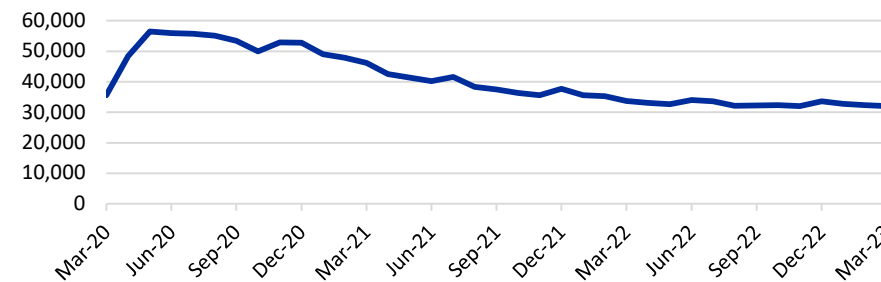

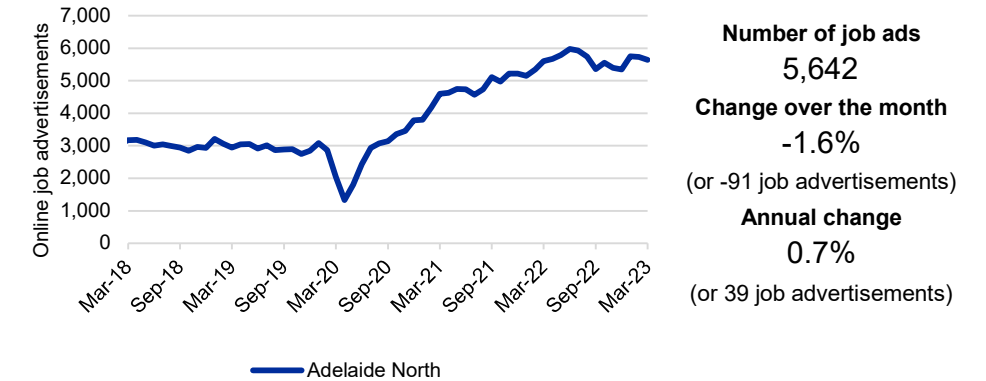

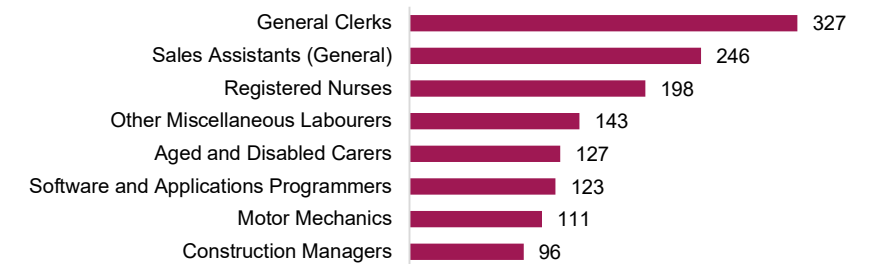

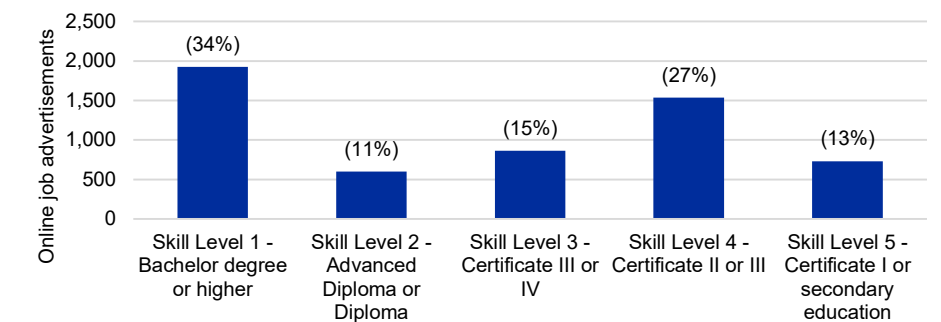

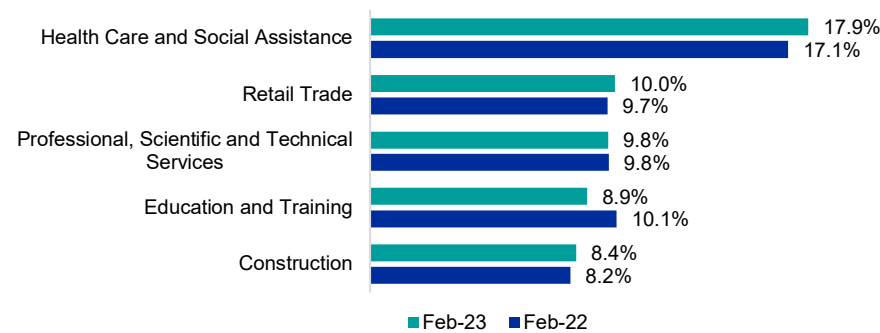

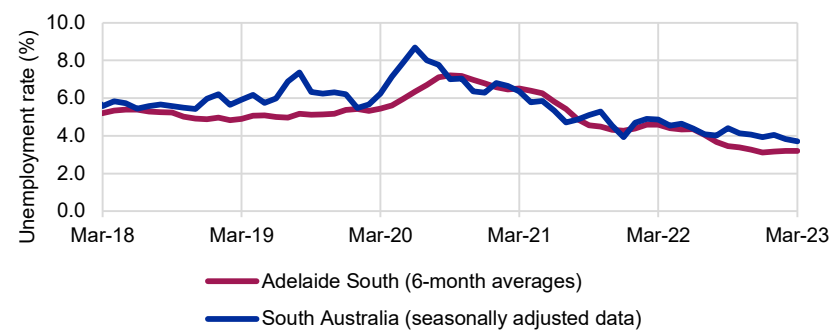

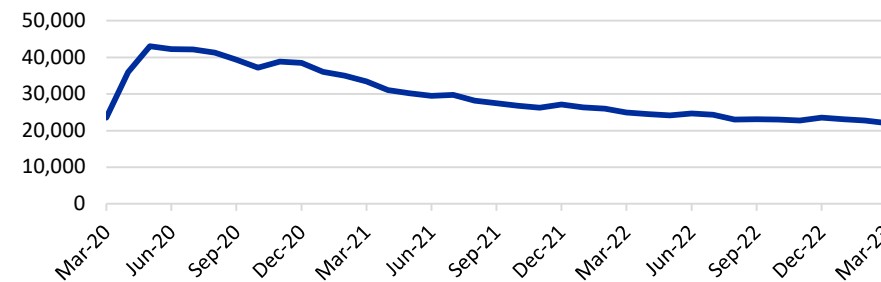

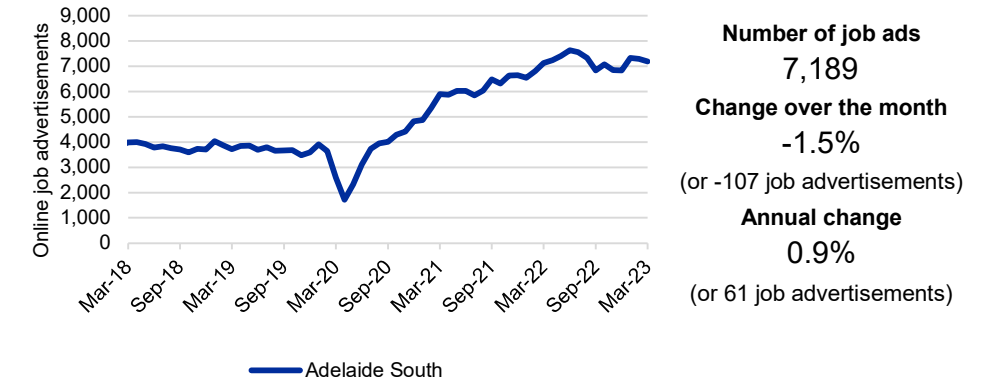

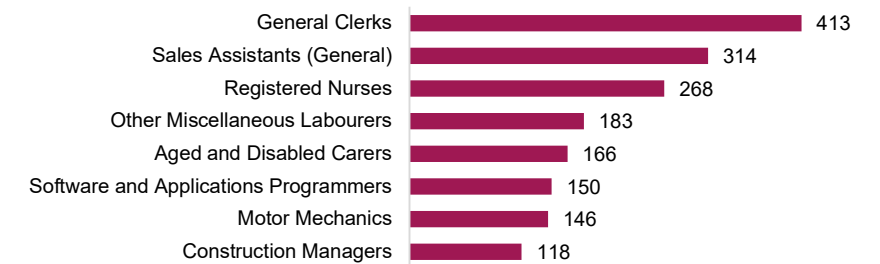

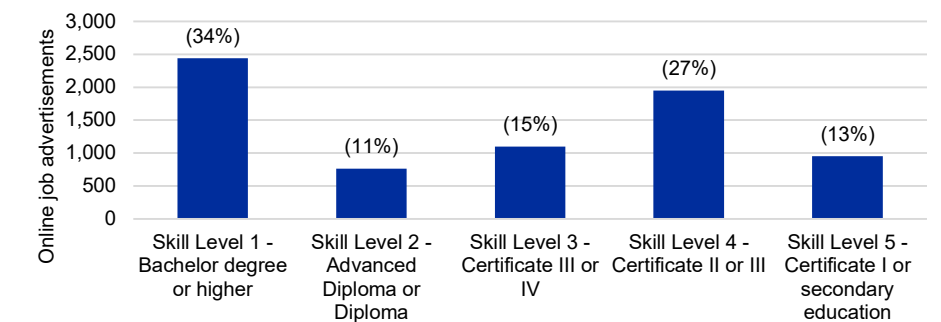

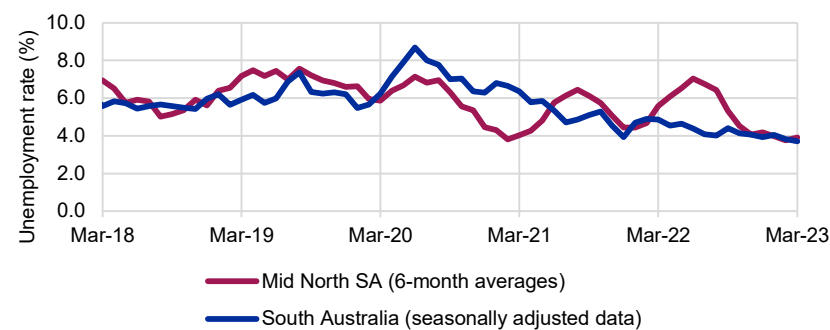

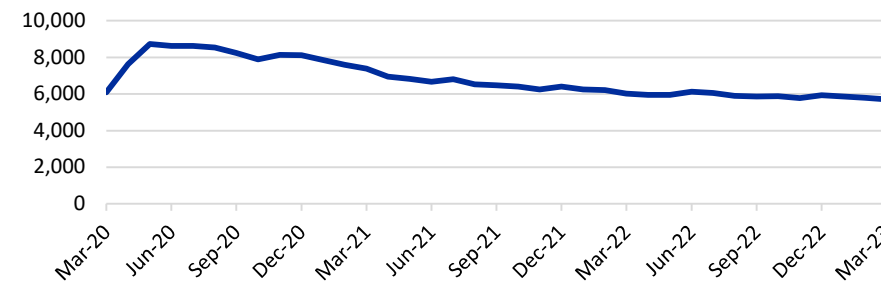

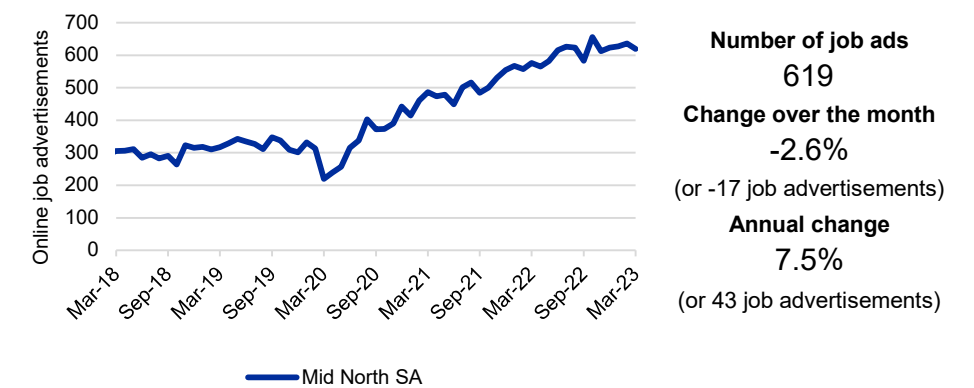

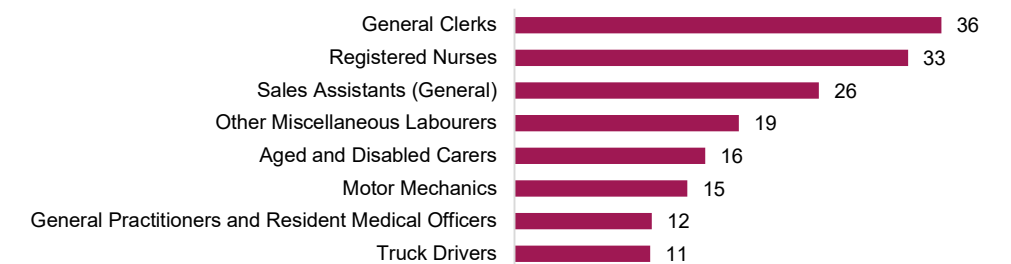

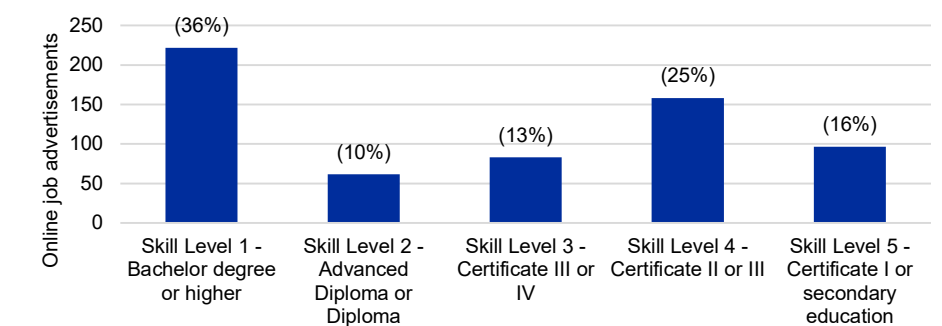

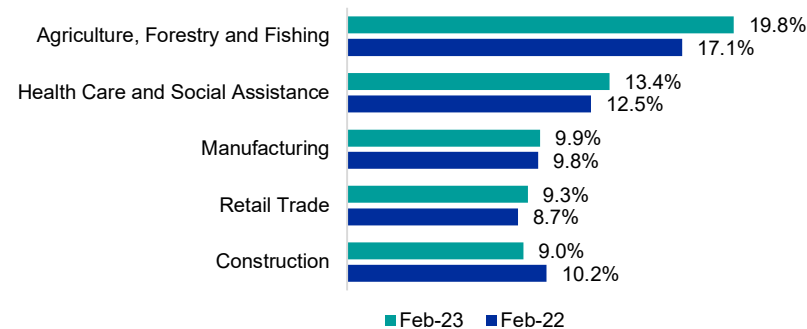

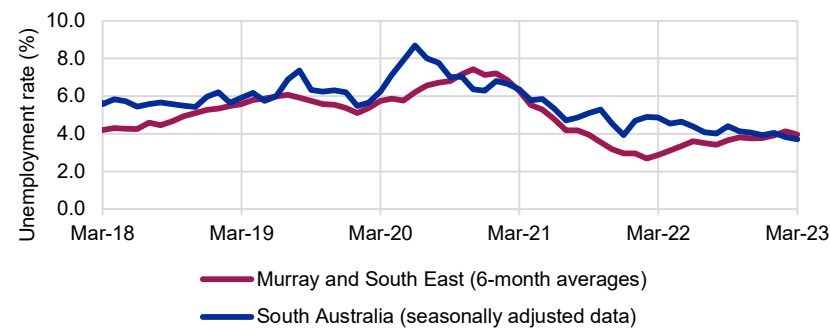

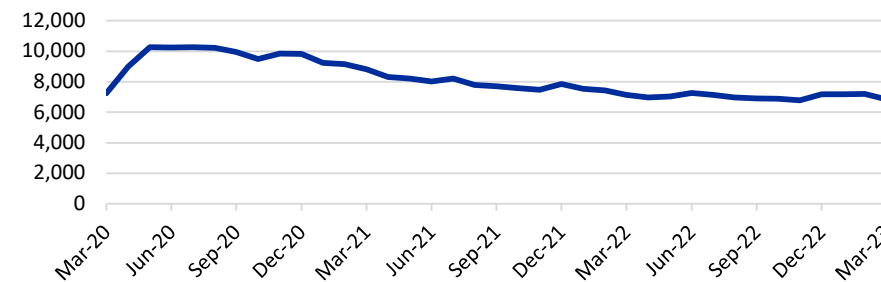

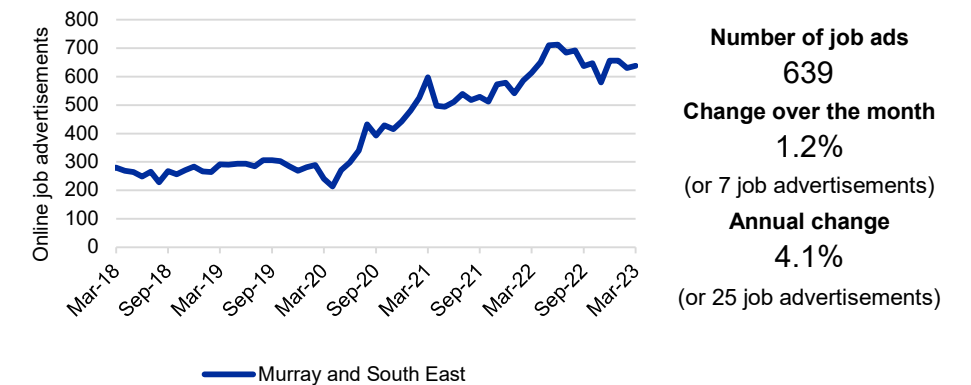

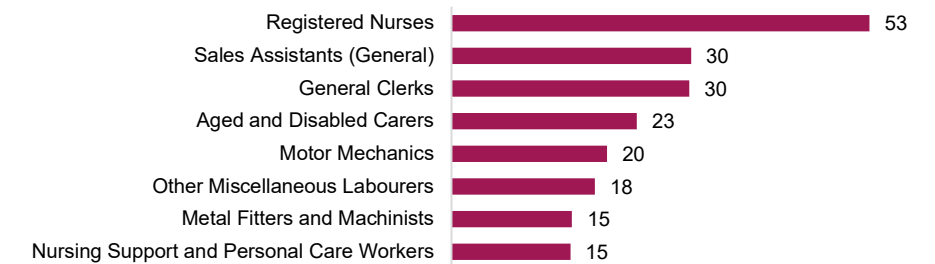

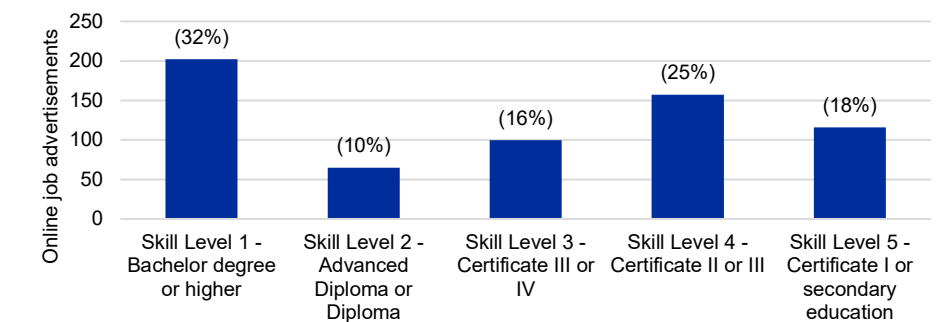

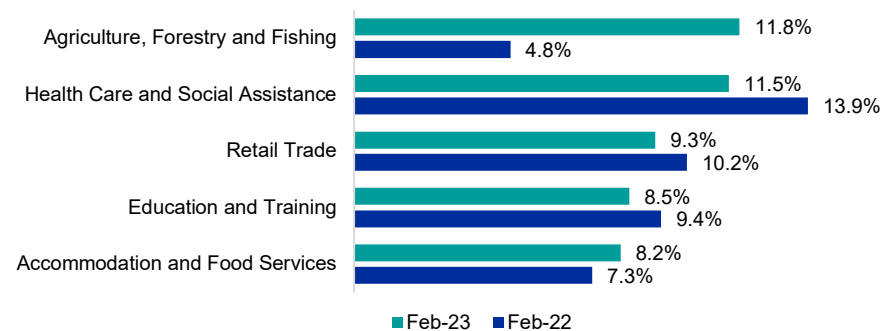

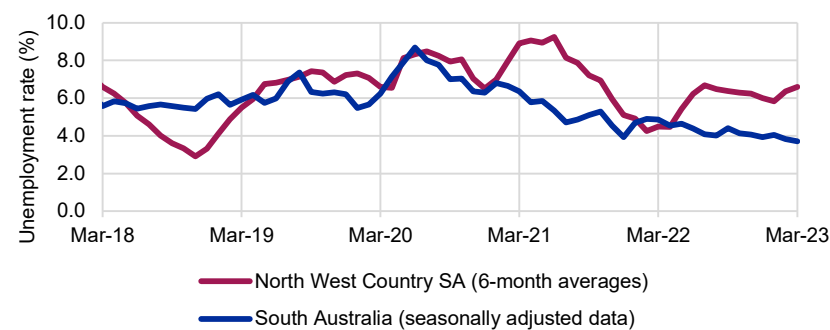

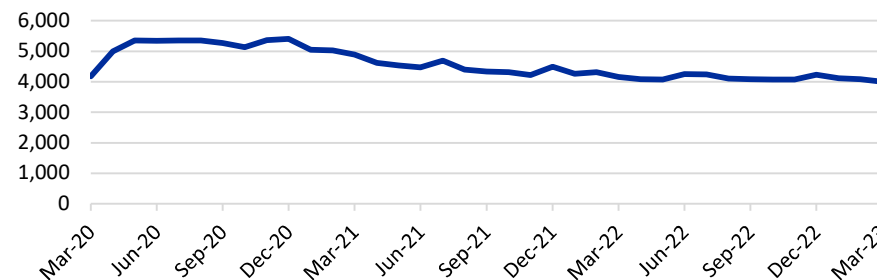

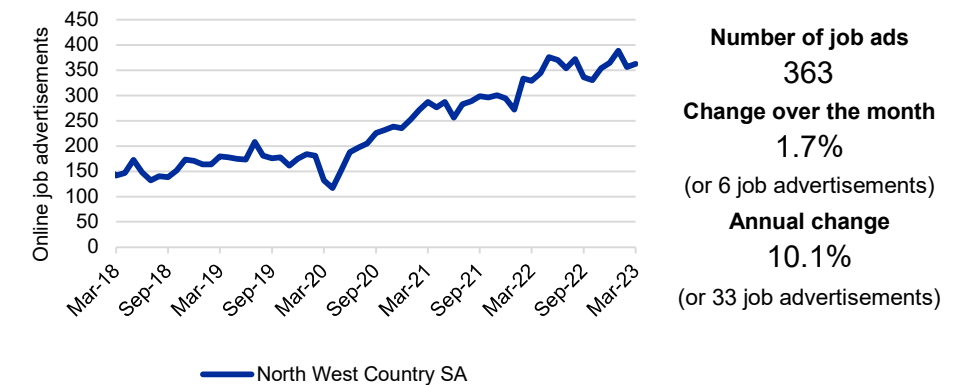

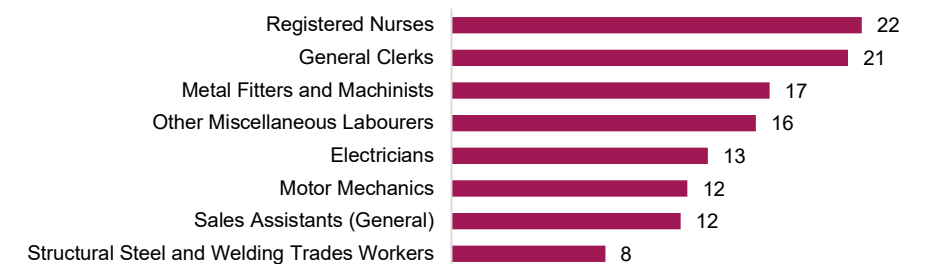

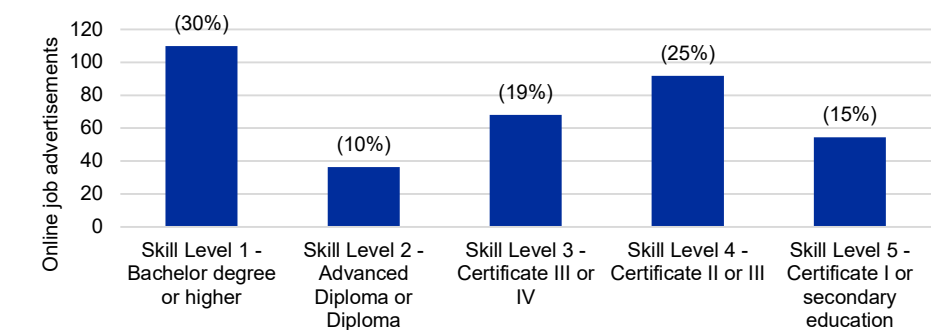
