Perth - North Employment Region

Overview


In August 2023, there were around 616,000 people employed in the Perth - North Employment Region. The 5 largest employing industries in the region were Health Care and Social Assistance, Professional, Scientific and Technical Services, Construction, Retail Trade, and Mining. Together these 5 industries accounted for 52% of employment in the region.

Over the year to August 2023, employment in:

- Health Care and Social Assistance rose by 0.6% to stand at 90,500
- Professional, Scientific and Technical Services rose by 18.1% to stand at 62,700
- Construction rose by 4.4% to stand at 59,400.

In Health Care and Social Assistance in the Perth - North Employment Region, 54% of workers were employed full-time; 79% were female; and the median age of the workforce was 41.

Employment by industry, August 2023 and August 2022



Five largest employing industries: key statistics



Note: In each chart, the solid line is the level of employment and the dotted line is a simple linear trend line for the 10 year period.


Employment characteristics by Industry
