### **Strategic Review of the Australian Apprenticeship Incentive System**

Thank you for your letter of 8 July 2024. In response to your request for data on the number of skilled workers by occupation required in the Care, Construction, and Clean Energy Sectors, and projections of the number of skilled workers in the occupations that that the economy is able to produce, please find attached a covering paper outlining the data provided, including any applicable caveats, with the relevant data sets embedded. Data includes:

- Clean Energy occupations data
- Care Workforce Labour Market Study data
- Data on Occupational Mobility that shows occupational mobility based on Australian Taxation Office data
- As requested in our discussion on Thursday 4 July, we have also included some more granular data on income for people who have taken apprenticeship and non-apprenticeship pathways.

Please note, we have not been able provide the latest employment projections from our Early Childhood Education and Care Capacity Study as they are currently being finalised. We are happy to provide those projections to you by Friday 2 August, noting that they will be under embargo until the Capacity Study report is published.

We do not currently have any specific supply and demand data on the Construction sector as this has not been the subject of a capacity study. The attached occupational mobility data does however cover construction occupations.
