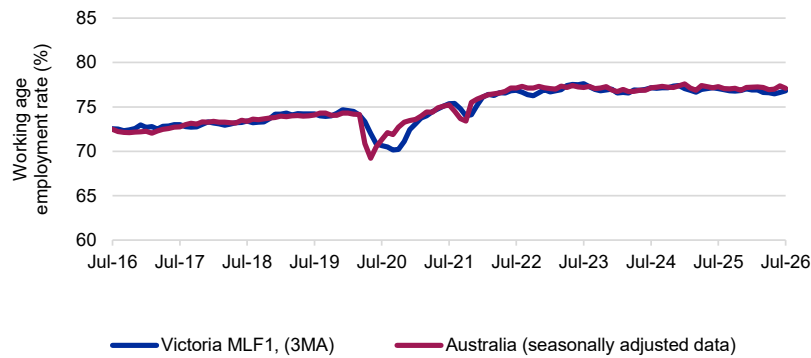

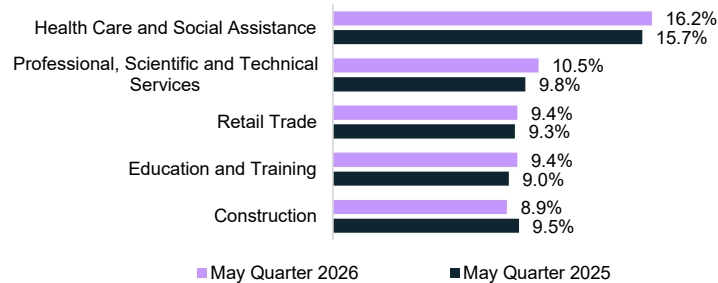

Working age employment rate



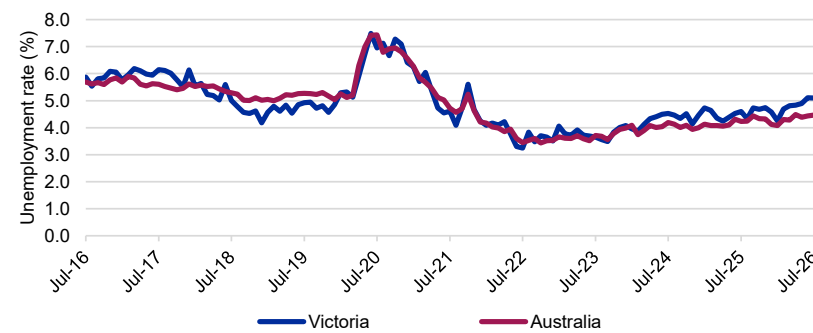

Largest employing industries



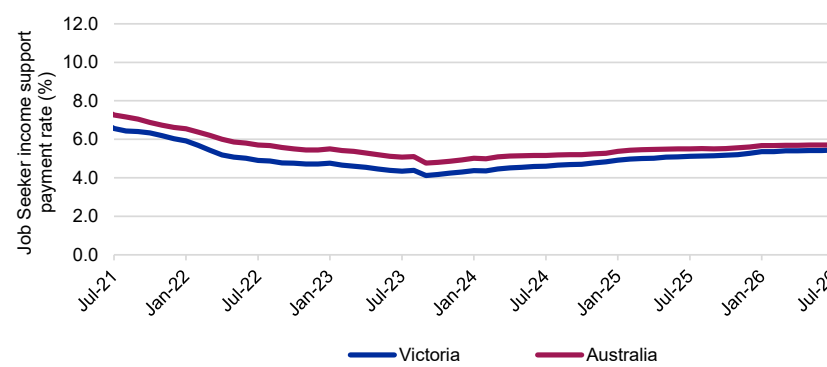

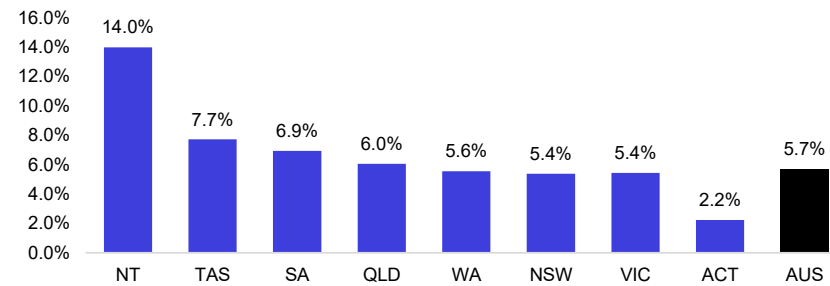
% of 15-64 year olds* on JobSeeker income support payments

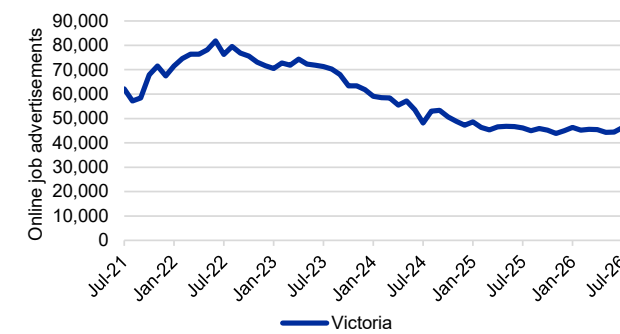

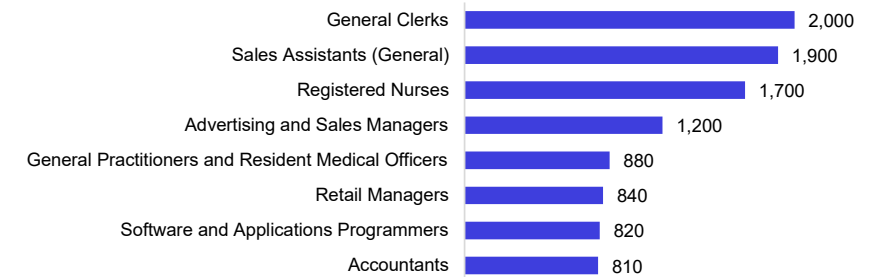

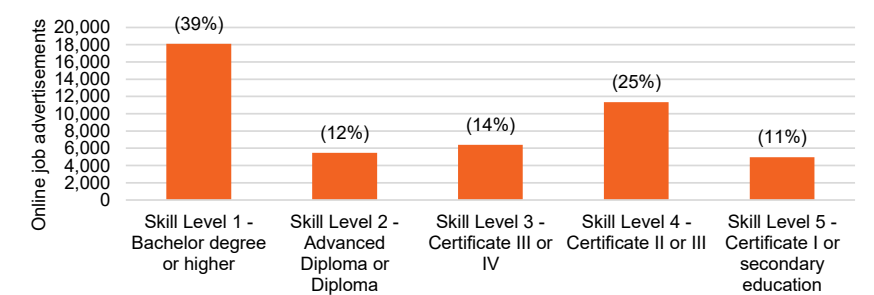
