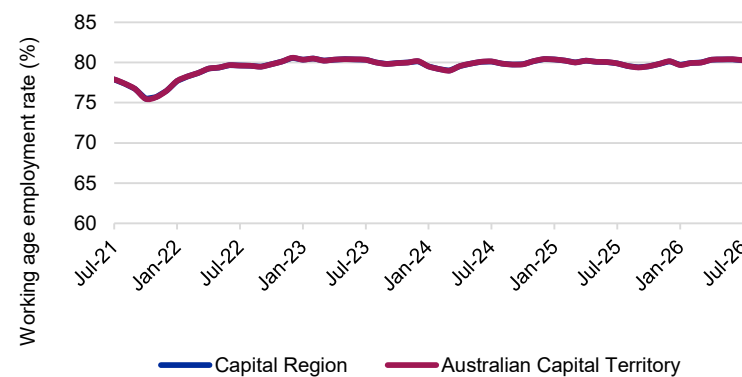

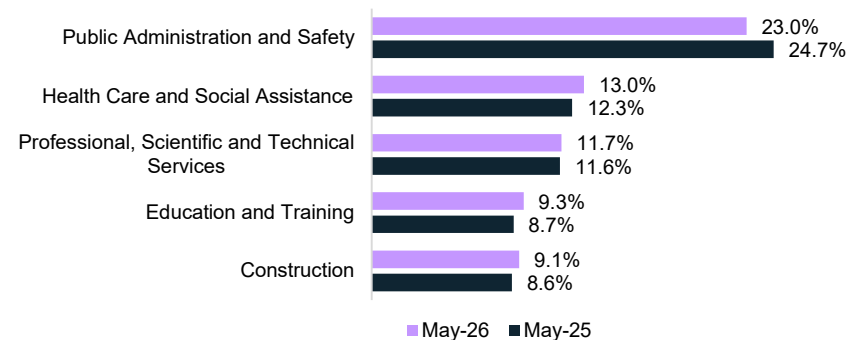

Working age employment rate (%)



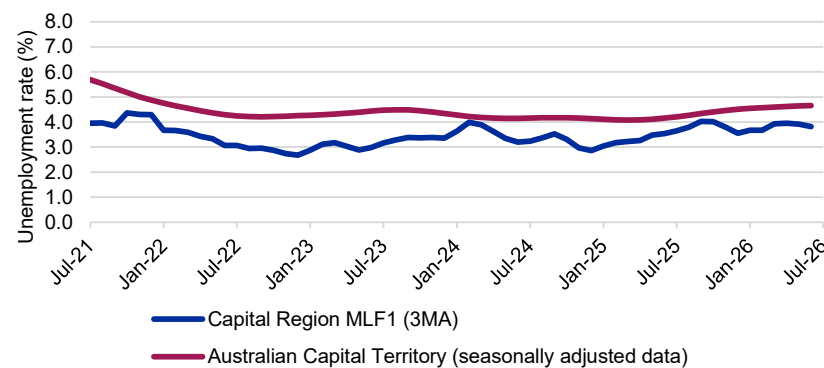

Largest employing industries



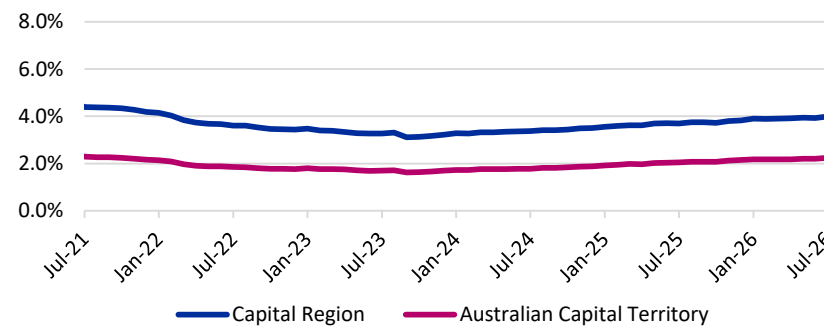

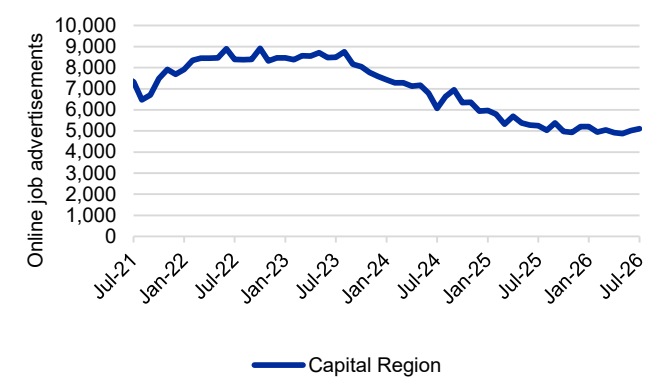

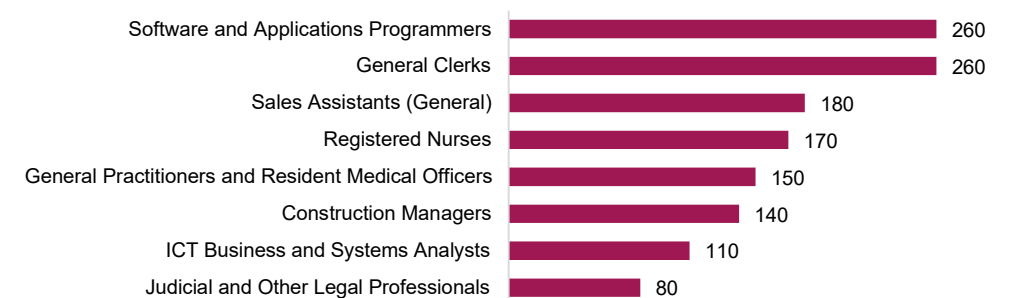

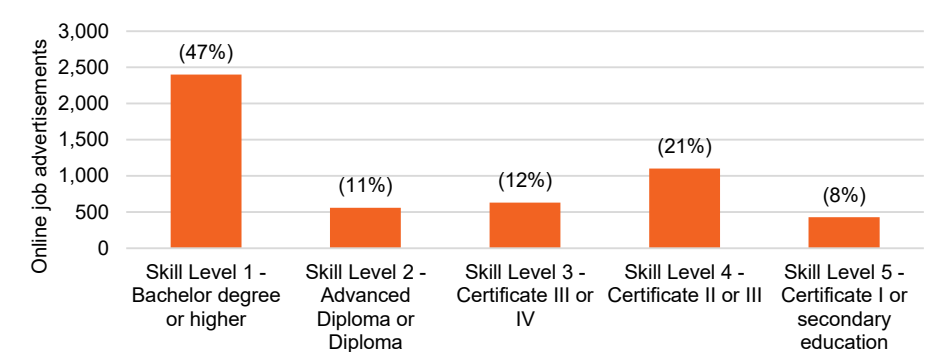
